production, alone or with red clover or alfalfa; or as a winter hardy, heat and drought tolerant component of high quality pasture. In pasture mixes, we recommend including 20 to 35 percent **Snowbelt Orchardgrass** by weight; use 4 to 8 pounds per acre when seeding with alfalfa or red clover for hay. **Snowbelt** prefers moderate to well drained soils and has good tolerance to heat and dryer conditions. For best results, seed into a firm seed bed when temperature and moisture will be

adequate but not excessive for at least 30 days after planting (generally March through early May in spring, August through early-October in fall). Herbicide is not usually needed, except to kill or suppress a sod for no-till planting. Late fall and early spring seedings will generally establish but not be highly productive the first summer. Fertilizer requirements are similar to other cool season grasses. **Snowbelt** should be harvested during the third week of May (just before head emergence) and every 30 to 40 days thereafter through the growing season either mechanically or by grazing. **Snowbelt** should <u>not</u> be harvested lower than 3-4 inches under any circumstance! Proper harvest height management is critical for regrowth, along with temperature and moisture conditions after harvest.

FSM Brand Snowbelt Orchardgrass is benefitted by **Myco-Seed Treat** for enhanced seedling establishment at a rate of 4oz/100#.

Use an **Agri-Energy Hay Fertility Program** to supply balanced nutrition throughout the growing season, including essential calcium, phosphorus, and potassium.

FSM Brand Snowbelt Orchardgrass is untreated and a non-GMO variety, however, always confirm acceptability for organic production with your certifying agency.
